ENABLE / DISABLE A COMBINATION, IMPORT .CSV

PS 1.6 & 1.7

Description:

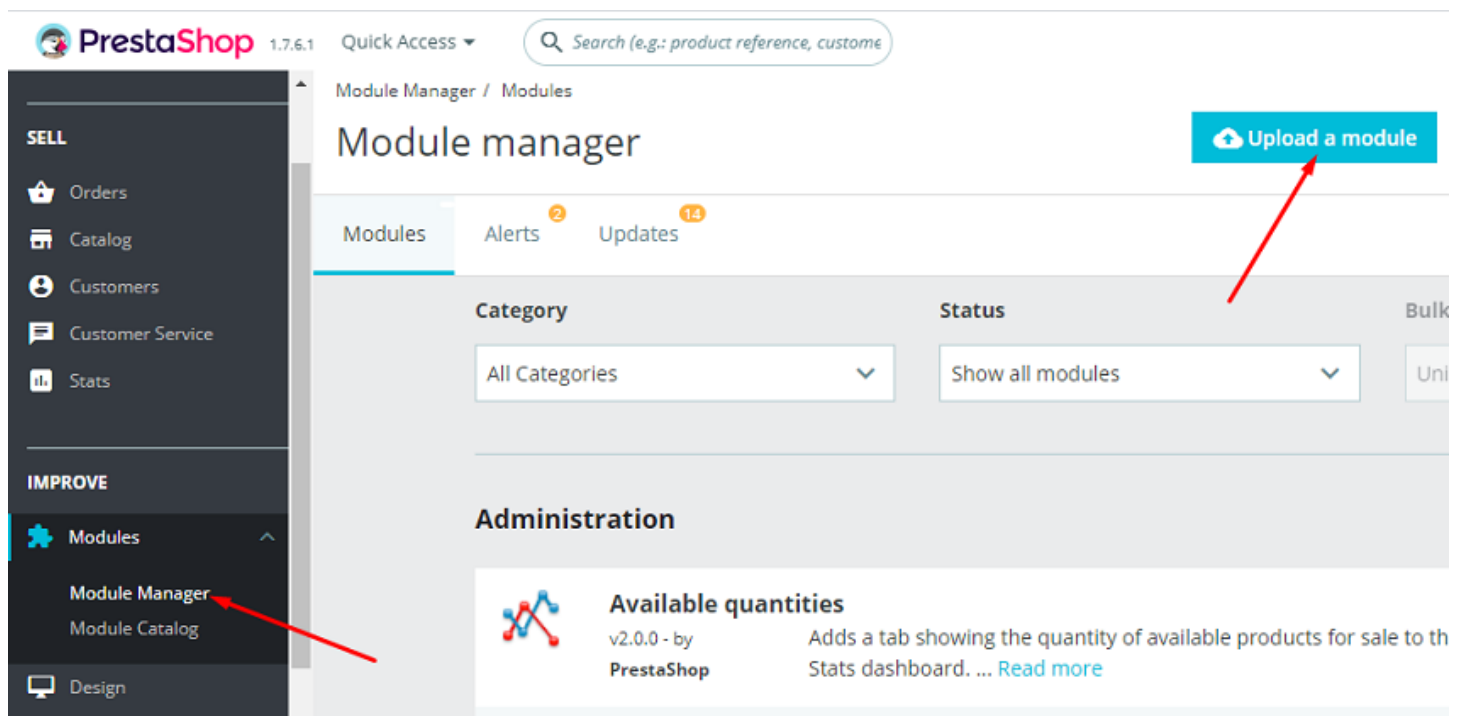
This module allows you to update combinations status without deleting them. You can enable or disable a product combination with one simple click or by importing a csv file.

Technical requirements for installation :

Prestashop, starting from the version 1.6.

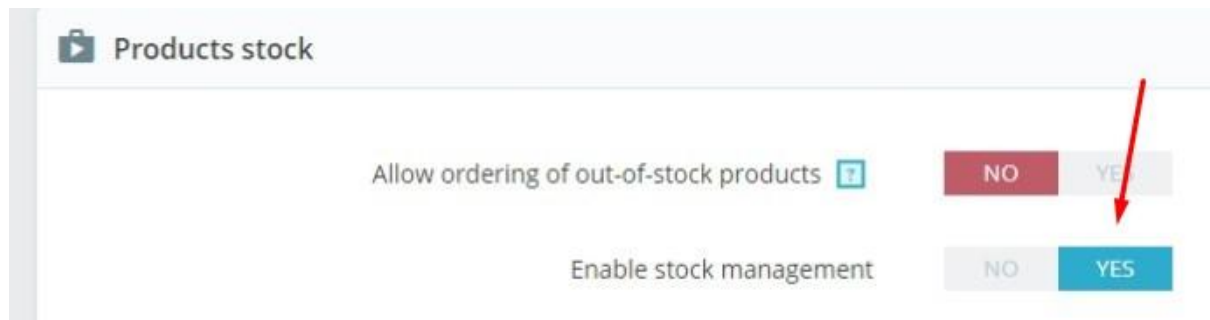
1. Installation

After downloading the module through the PrestaShop Addons platform, simply go to the "Modules Manager" tab in your back office and upload the downloaded file.



2. Preliminary PrestaShop configurations

The module works correctly if the stock management option is enabled. Check this option via the PrestaShop menu, "Shop Parameters"> "Product Settings"



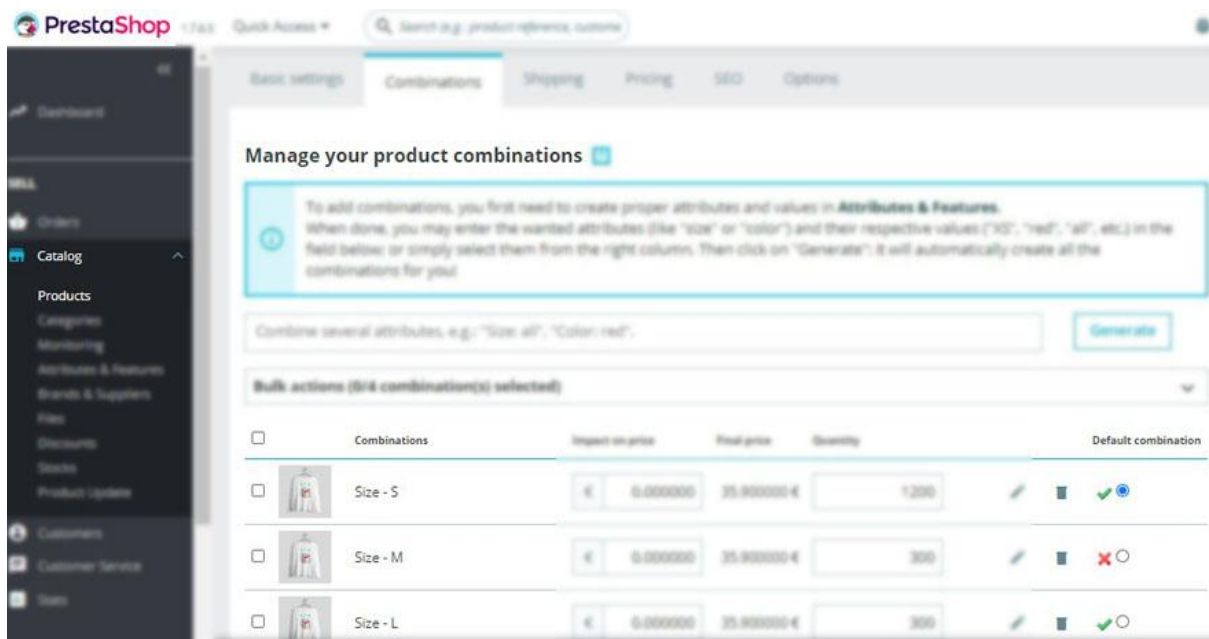
3. Manage product combinations

The module can work with only one type of combination (like sizes) or with multiple combinations (as sizes and colors).

Now you can start managing easily your products combinations. You can update the status of the combinations in three ways.

- Through the product page in back office
- Through the module's "General" tab
- By importing a CSV file.

The most used way is through the product sheet. To update a combination, go to Catalog > Products> Your product > Combinations.



You can then choose your default combination and enable or disable the desired combinations. It is not necessary to click on the "Save" button after making changes to the combinations' status. Just click on the combination symbol to change status:

Red cross: combination disabled
Green tick: Combination active

Remember that a combination will be disabled despite the amount of items still available.

Be careful: If you use multi-shop environment and you select "All the shops" one combination will be displayed as disabled if it was disabled at least in one shop.

We will see the other two update methods in the "Module configuration" chapter.

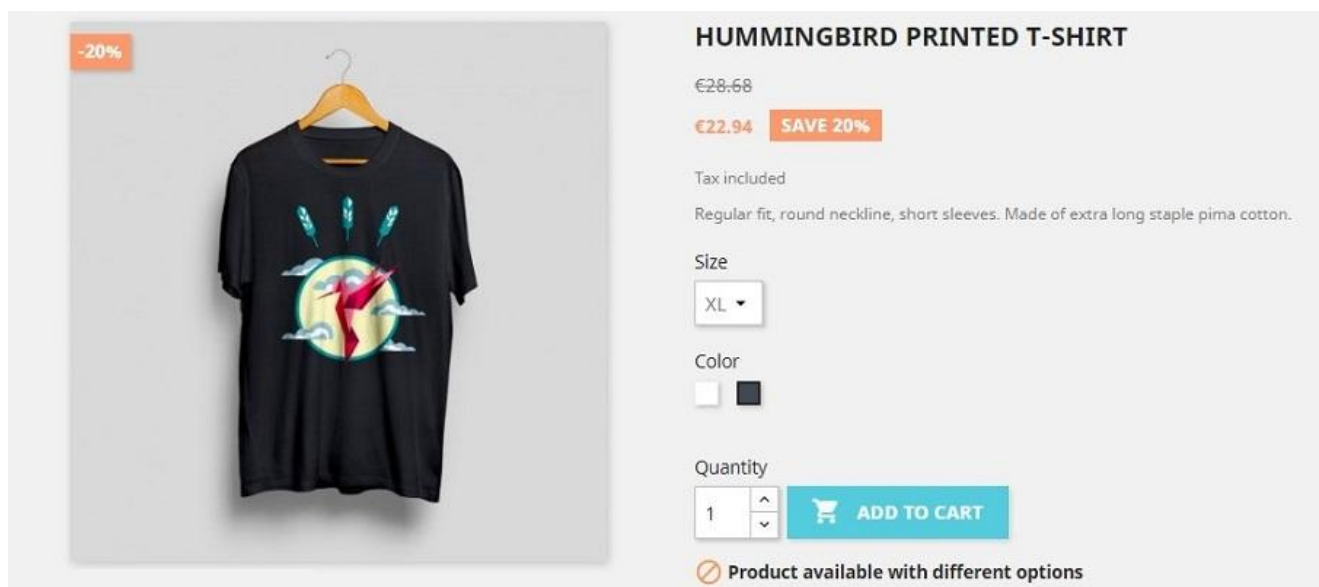
4. How the module modifies the product page

If your product has only one type of combination, for example the size, the disabled combinations will not be shown to your customers.

For this product we have deactivated the combination "Size M".



If your product has multiple combinations (as sizes and colors), **all combinations will be shown**, but deactivated items will be unavailable.



This is to prevent the customer from getting stuck in choosing his product. In the image, the black T shirt, is not available in XL size.

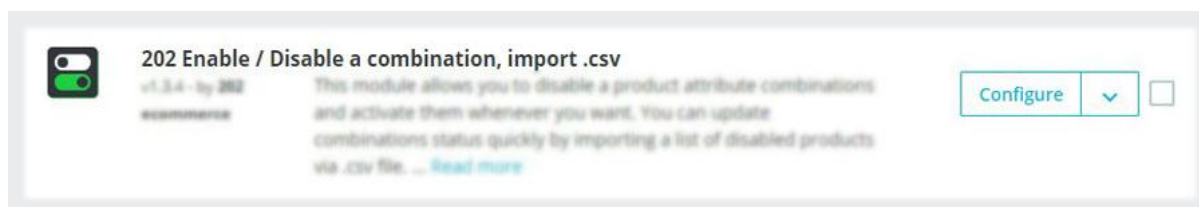
But there are black T shirts in other sizes and there are XL sizes in other colors. So the two attributes (XL and black) are not hidden.

If an attribute is completely disabled, the module makes it invisible to your customers. For example, if all XL sizes are disabled, the module will hide this size. Or, if all black colors are disabled, the module will hide this color. Here's what we'll see if all "black" combinations are disabled.



5. Module Configuration

You can access the configuration panel by clicking the “Configure” button.



The menu is composed of three tabs:

- General
- Import .CSV
- See more

5.1 General

In the General tab, you will see the list of all the combinations disabled in the module configuration panel. The name of the Shop in which the product is deactivated is also specified.

By clicking on the red cross, next to each product, the status will be changed to “active” and **the item will disappear** from the list. This is the second way to update the status of the combinations.

In the same page, you can find the option “Disable product if no available combinations”. This option hides the product from your clients if **all combinations** are disabled.

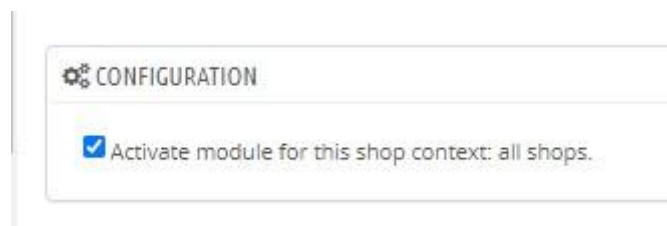

Remember: the module cannot hide the deactivated combinations if customer uses **faceted search**.

At the end of the page, there is an additional option that allows you to choose whether to activate or deactivate the module in the selected shop.





5.2 Import .CSV

We will now see the third way to modify the status of your combinations.

This tab is very useful for modifying the status of several combinations of products at the same time by importing a .csv file. Your .csv file can contain different columns, but the module will need to identify only the one with the combination IDs and the one with their status.

Each combination can be associated through the EAN code, the reference, the UPC barcode, the supplier reference. These values have to match in the file and in your back office.

Upload your file and proceed, therefore, and indicate the ID to refer and the column to associate in the .csv file.

 You should select a type of your product identifier. It could be EAN Code, Reference, UPC Barcode, Supplier Product Reference or product combination. Once selected, you should associate it to the column in your .csv file. You can open your .csv file in Excel for finding the right column name. 

Associate products (REF/EAN/UPC/Supplier Reference) to column in .csv:

Choose columnA

Indicate, next, the determinant to use in order to update the status of combinations.

1) If you select "quantity":

- combinations with a quantity greater than or equal to "1" will be activated
- Combinations with quantity equal to "0" will be disabled
- If, in the file, the quantity field is empty, the status of the combination will not be updated.

2) If you select "Combination status" as determinant, the corresponding field in the file should correspond to "0" to deactivate a combination and "1" to activate it.

Once you have chosen the determinant, you can associate the column in your .csv file.

Associate quantity/status to column:

Choose type of determinantQuantity

====>

Choose columnB

Exclude the first line of your file from the import if it corresponds to the header of the columns.

Finally, click on the "Import CSV button". The module will show a confirmation message if the import was successful.
